1st Step: Logon on to Protex, <http://xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx> – xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx it the Protex's LAN interface.

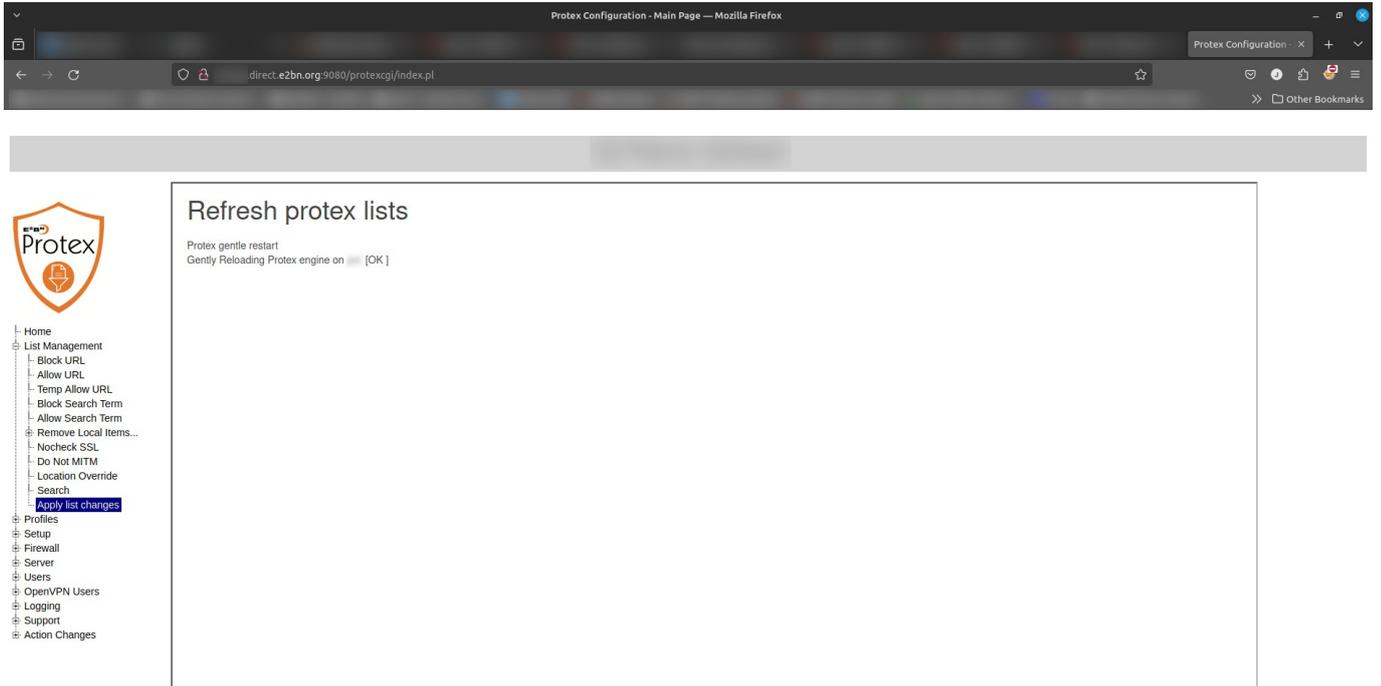
